This Sunday, June 18, the Choir will break for the summer months. At this time my thanks to the choir members for

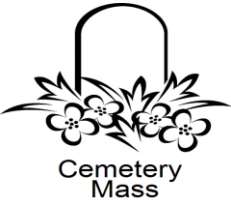
